Thirteenth EU-sanctions package 2033/1214 against Russia

Ladies and Gentlemen,

the EU-member states have adopted a further package of sanctions against Russia. With the adoption of the thirteenth sanctions package, the European Union is sending a further signal of solidarity with the attacked country. In the updated EU Regulation 2033/1214 of 26.02.2024, the requirements for the steel production and processing process are further specified.

Example:

12 Article 3g is amended as follows:

(a) paragraph 1(d) is replaced by the following:

"(d) to import or purchase, directly or indirectly, iron and steel products listed in Annex XVII from September 30, 2023, if they have been processed in a third country using iron and steel products listed in Annex XVII originating in Russia; for products listed in Annex XVII that have been processed in a third country using steel products falling within CN code 7207 1 1 or 7207 12 10 or 7224 90 originating in Russia, this prohibition shall apply from 1. April 2024 for CN code 7207 1 1 and from October 1, 2024 for CN codes 7207 12 10 and 7224 90; L 159 1/10 EN Official Journal of the European Union 23.6.2023 for the purposes of the application of this point, importers must provide proof of the country of origin of the iron and steel inputs used for the processing of the product in a third country at the time of importation;"

We hereby confirm your compliance with the above sanctions.
